As requested, please find enclosed an application for Islamic Divorce (Talaq).

Before applying, we request you to read the following carefully:

ISLAMIC DIVORCE (TALAQ) APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

- This is an application for Talaq. It is not to issue a Talaq immediately.
- After completing the application form, we will be in touch with you to explore the possibilities of mediation and reconciliation.
- The wife (Respondent) must be informed and given a chance to share her thoughts.
- As such, Applicants must participate in joint meetings (unless there are any legal impediments) if requested by the Council. These meetings are held in person or virtually. The purpose of the meeting is not necessarily to reconcile, but also to seek closure and avoid delaying the case.
- Unreasonable refusal to participate in a meeting when requested may result in the case being put on hold or dismissed.
- If it is apparent that divorce is the only viable option, the Council will approve the application and the Applicant will finalise the Talaq by completing and signing a separate form (as instructed by the Council) in the presence of two witnesses.
- If Talaq is issued, the Applicant **MUST** ensure to settle any outstanding mahr payments.
- The Applicant may also be required to apply for a Civil Divorce (where applicable).
- The Applicant must not simultaneously apply for an Islamic Divorce at any other Shariah Council. If they do, their case with us will be closed and the fee will not be refunded.
- When applying, please send the completed form to us with photocopies or scans of the following:

- A. Your Islamic Marriage (Nikah) certificate.
- B. Photo ID (Passport or driving license).
- C. Proof of Address (Bank statement/utility bill not older than three months).
- D. A statement explaining the reasons for applying for an Islamic Divorce.
